The topic of the December Technical Session will be [Energy Efficient Dehumidification and Heat Recovery – “What’s new for efficient IAQ”](#)

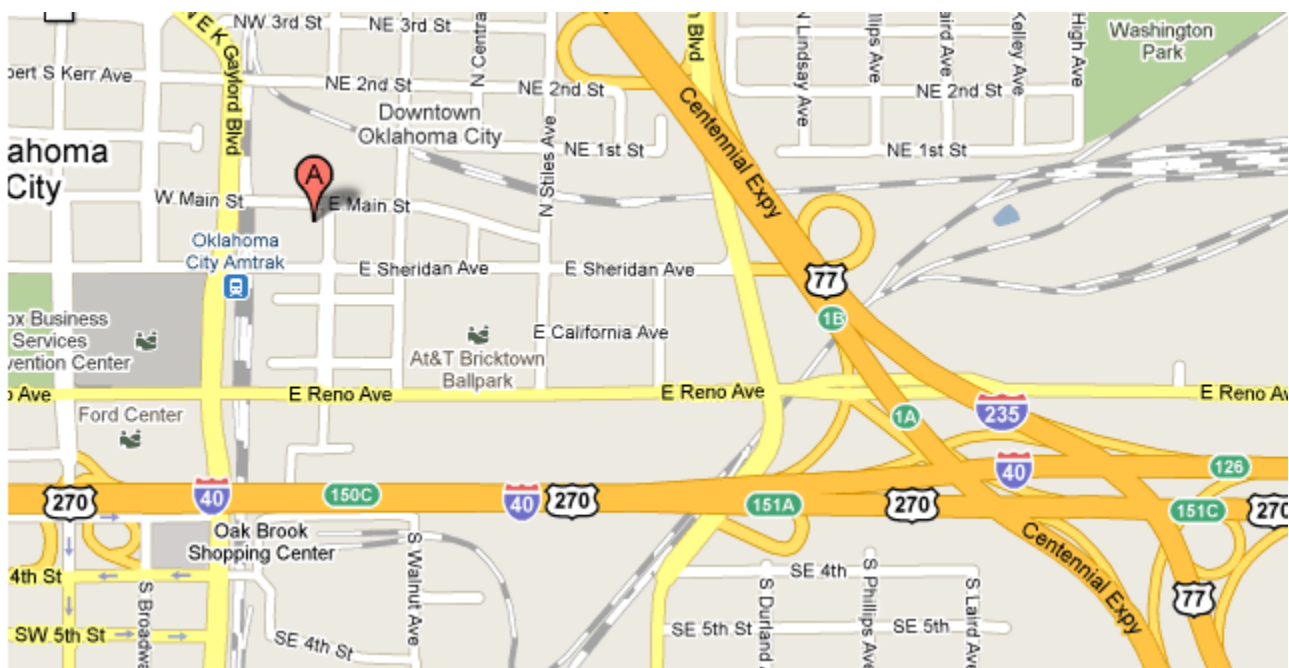
